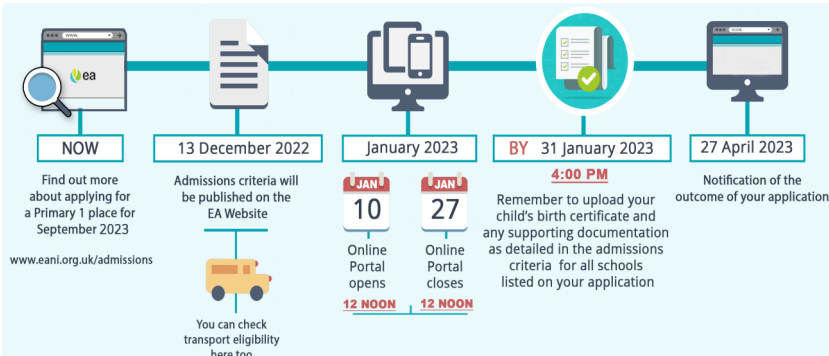


New Admissions 2024

Children born on or between 2 July 2018 and 1 July 2019 are compulsory school age in September 2023

Children born on or between 2 July 2019 and 1 July 2020 can apply for a place in a reception class

Our Swimming Programme for P5, 6 and 7 children will begin this term on the following date:

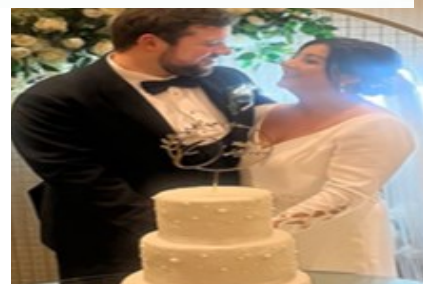
Monday 29th January 2024

Strike Day 18th January

Reminder: All absences should be followed up with a note for the class teacher. Please record the date and reason for the absence.

The strike is happening because the 5 teacher unions are campaigning for a fair pay settlement for teachers. Teachers' pay has dropped by a staggering 25% in the past decade, causing recruitment and retention issues, resulting in a continued shortage of teachers. Teachers in England are paid £6000 more than here, in Scotland it's £8000 and in the south, £12000 more. It's time to take action and demand a fair pay settlement for those responsible for providing the best education for children and young people.
