### If you are unable to collect your child:

We will only release children into the care of individuals named by the parent/carer by means of a signed note or a phone call. This is particularly important when children are visiting friends houses eg birthday parties. Children can not be lifted by a friend's parent without notice being given to the class teacher/principal before hand.




The Library van will visit our school on Tuesday 5th/19th September from 10am-11am. It will be at the Community Centre from 11am.
