

This year Shrove Tuesday falls on Tuesday, 13th Feb and Ash Wednesday on Wednesday, 14th February It marks the beginning of six and a half weeks of repentance, fasting and abstinence in preparation for Easter. The ashes from the palms (which have been blessed), that have been kept from last year's Palm Sunday, are mixed with holy water to make a greyish paste. When people go to church on Ash Wednesday, the priest dips his thumb in the paste and uses it

to make the sign of the cross on each person's forehead.
