Authorisation for collection of children:

If you are unable to collect your child:

If someone else is to collect your child, or you are allowing them to walk home on their own, please inform the class teacher by means of a signed note or a phone call. We will only release children into the care of individuals named by the parent/carer by means of a signed note or a phone call. This is particularly important when children are visiting friends' houses e.g. birthday parties. Children **can not** be lifted by a friend's parent without notice being given to the class teacher/principal beforehand.
